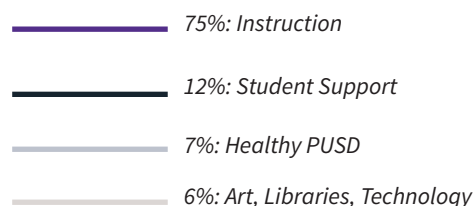
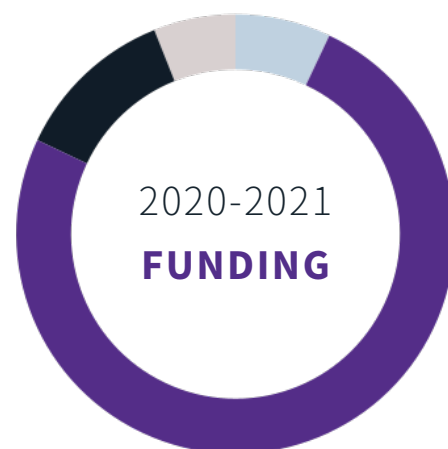

TOTAL GRANT TO PUSD \$3,015,704

The funds granted to PUSD focus on four core areas of education: Instruction, Student Support, Healthy PUSD, and Art, Libraries, & Technology.

Traditionally, 75% of the PEF grant funds teachers & classroom instruction. More teachers means more classes and smaller class sizes, allowing for individualized attention and instruction.

For the coming 2021-2022 school year, the PEF grant will focus more on Healthy PUSD, helping the District make physical and mental health a priority in opening our schools fully, and safely, in the new school year.
